ADAPTING TO THE CURRENT SITUATION

End of Winter Z'man and Bein Hazmanim As the threat of the pandemic rose up soon after Purim; the Hanholas Hayeshiva unfortunately had to take the decision to send all the Talmidim home. More than 130 foreign Talmidim had already left, to avoid quarantine in their home cities. As the remaining Talmidim were preparing to leave, the Mashgiach, Rav Gershon Miller א"ליט" gave a unique shmues in the שליט" to prepare them for the forthcoming extended time away from כותלי הישיבה https://gyalumni.org/shiurim/

Until the end of Zman, The Rosh Yeshiva Harav Avrohom Gurwicz שליט"א gave a daily Shiur via teleconference every evening (allowing US and Canadian Talmidim to hear it at a reasonable time), and the Mashgiach , Rav Mordechai Yosef Karnowsky שליט"א gave some שיעורים בעניני The Mashgiach Rav Gershon gave a דיומא each morning, this continued during Bein Hazmanim, including Too

מסכת בבא קמא approached, the Hanholoh assisted by the admin team arranged for all the regular shiurim to be held via teleconference technology to ensure the smooth and uninterrupted relaying of the shiurim, and in particular to enable the Talmidim to discuss the shiur and their Talmidim to discuss the shiur and their שיעור כללי on an individual basis. The שיעור כללי shmuessen and שיעור כללי have all been successful and well attended, in excess of 85000 minutes in one week. We are delighted that many Alumni are also able to connect and 'rejoin'.

Every Talmid receives מראה מקומות each day by email. In addition, a dial-in system is in place for all relevant information, timetable, any change in schedule, along with simcha announcements. This line has received over three thousand calls to date. The weekly בחינת חומש רש"י בכתב is sent by email with the answers following once most of the scripts are returned.

FINANCES

The finances of the Yeshiva are under serious threat with extreme cash flow problems arising particularly between Purim and Pesach – especially since no fundraising visits could take place. Once again, Achisomoch Aid Company (founded by the Yeshiva Alumni members), came to the rescue and arranged a very substantial contribution. Many parents are struggling to meet the Yeshiva's requests for tuition in the summer Z'man and the Yeshiva appeals to all

parents and supporters to help at this difficult time and to make every effort to settle outstanding dues and pledges as soon as possible, directly to the Yeshiva or by visiting the website at www.gyalumni.org/donate.

THE YESHIVA DINNER - JANUARY 2020

On 21st January, we held the Gateshead Yeshiva Dinner, at the Meridian Grand in London, celebrating 90 years since the inception of the Yeshiva. RECEPTION: The Reception was an opportunity for talmidim to reconnect with the Rabonei Hayeshiva. On display were 3 recently discovered letters relating to the early years of the Yeshiva. One from the Chofetz Chaim אנייל, dated 1929 recommending the appointment of Harav Nachman Dovid Landynski אנייל, as the first Rosh Yeshiva. The second, sent by the Yeshiva to the Vaad Harabonim of America in 1936 requesting גמרות נדרים ובנא מציעא. The third, dated selichos of

1951 to Harav Landynski who had moved to the USA, wishing the Rosh Yeshiva ברכת שנה UEA, wishing the Rosh Yeshiva ברכת שנה UEA, wishing the Rosh Yeshiva נטובה.

A new innovation was launched - the אוצר השערים project, a compilation of all the ספרים that have been penned by Gateshead Yeshiva alumni. Many authors have been in contact and some submitted their publications. Plans are in place to house these in a special אוצר in the Yeshiva.

DINNER The chairman, Reb Yisroel Stern, welcomed the guests. A Siyum of שים משניות and Kaddish was recited by the Mashgiach, Harav Mordechai Yosef Karnowsky שליטיא. The שליטיא was dedicated to the memory of Rebbetzin Gittel Kaplan יבלח"ט, daughter of the Rosh Hayeshiva, שליטיא Harav Avraham Gurwicz

The top table was graced by all Rabbonei Hayeshiva along with leading אנים ורבני העיר.

Many alumni had not seen their fellow talmidim since they left the Yeshiva many decades ago. Many early Alumni attended including one person who was present in the late 30's.

The "Alumni Choir" led by Moshe Yosef Fordsham added to the pleasure of the evening.

HACHOVER AWARDS. Tributes were paid to the askanim who had set up the Alumni Association in the mid 70's and are no longer with us - Messrs Arnold Cohen ל"ל, Avrohom Shmuel Goldberg הי"ד, Yisroel Reich ל"ז, and Rabbi Chaim Yaakov Davis ל"ז.

Yitzchok Katz and David Chontow are credited with running Achisomoch for decades, which has benefitted Gateshead Yeshiva with millions of pounds since its inception. In recognition

of their work for the kehillah in general and Gateshead Yeshiva in particular, the Hanholas Yeshiva awarded them both the title of 'Chaver'. The special text bestowing the title of Chaver was written out on klaf, and signed by the Hanholo and Rabbi Yisroel Meir Greenberg אַליט", Rav of GGBH, where both honorees are mispallelim.

ROSH HAYESHIVA The high point of the evening was the Rosh Yeshiva's drosho. As the Rosh Hayeshiva prepared to speak, the whole assembly rose to their feet and spontaneously began a rekidah in his honour. In his inspiring words, the Rosh Yeshiva spoke of the difference between מלאכה and מלאכה.

APPEAL An appeal was launched during the evening on behalf of the Yeshiva.

The raffle prize of a leather-bound Shas, with the iconic Yeshiva emblem embossed on each volume was won by Mr Zvi Rothbard of Stamford Hill.

Reb Stanley demonstrated many special qualities; He was absolutely reliable and honest, dependable, astute and conscientious, and the Hanholas HaYeshiva knew that its financial and administrative affairs were in safe hands. Mr and

Mrs Esofsky's home was a powerhouse of Chesed and with his easy-going nature, no one (Talmidim or parents) was refused an appointment, a meal, a car ride or any other chesed.

In recent years, when enjoying semi – retirement (during which he still maintained his office in the Yeshiva and his signature graced every official Yeshiva letter!) he filled his days with learning and walking (often with great effort) from one Shiur to another.

A Talmid's perspective - Moshe Boruch Katanka

The day we never imagined would come – the day our Rebbe was taken from us!

For all these years we had before us a דוגמא חיה - a live example of someone who was ייראתו קודמת לחכמתו'. As much as he was known for his clarity in הלכה, we saw in him a person overflowing with יראת and אהבת הבריות.

We remember his exceptional clarity – how many תלמידים enjoyed their first taste of הלכה in his unforgettable שיעורים. How many of those תלמידים are now themselves מרביצי תורה and in turn give over his שיעורים to the next

We remember the שמחה that he had in explaining each דין, how he would bring it to life with real life examples and samples that he brought to שיעור.

We remember how he would say 'אותיות מחכימות' the importance of seeing every הלכה inside to be able to build on it and challenge it.

We remember his tremendous - ענוה - how he would say that he is only a 'tape recorder' giving over the פסקים of the heiliger Chofetz Chaim, when in fact we had in front of us one of the greatest פוסקים of our times!

We remember how he would want our involvement during the - "How can one give a שיעור in a בית הקברות?" he would tell us from Rav Shach ז....

We remember how he taught us that הלכה isn't just a list of rules - it's a way of life! He would give an explanation for every דין and every הלכה, to make it memorable and palatable.

We remember how much we looked forward to his דברי חיזוק before a new מסיבה. It wasn't just the vort or story that he said, it was the way that the vort came over – it was for real, it came from his heart.

We remember his patience – how he would wait after שיעור until

the very last בחור had asked all his questions although at times he was literally at the point of exhaustion.

We can visualize him walking up the back alley talking in learning with the בחורים. How he would stop walking and face the דבחור rather than continue walking – to show how much he was interested in the שואל.

We remember his סבר פנים יפות, he would talk in learning with each and every מלמיד as if it was the first time he had heard this שאילה. Every answer was given with an explanation. No question was too small or too big.

We remember how he would try to call each טבחור by his first name to show how much he was valued.

We remember how he would walk all the way around the ישיבה complex albeit with difficulty so that he could slip in the בית המדרש for מנחה מנחה having to stand up for him.

We remember the 'farhers' that he made around his table at the end of each מלאכה where he would ensure that no שחור would feel uncomfortable even if he didn't know the answer...

And now – 'ואיננו, כי לקח אתו – the day came and הקדוש took him away from us.

But we won't just remember, we will build and continue his legacy.
